These Terms and Conditions apply to the activities/promotions run through the Community Rugby Program (**Activities**) conducted by Australian Rugby Union and/or their nominee and affiliates (**ARU**). These Terms and Conditions may be amended or varied from time to time.

Approval for Publications

During your participation in the Activities photos and video footage may be taken and published on ARU's website, social media, newspapers, newsletters, education journals and used for other purposes by ARU. By participating in the Activities you acknowledge your acceptance with this clause.

Privacy

Privacy Statement: ARU respects the privacy of the individuals on whom ARU collects uses and discloses personal information. ARU is bound by the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and has a Privacy Policy that safeguards your privacy. Permission Forms

For Activities that are run at a school or when a school attends an Activity as part of a school excursion, ARU understands that your school will follow appropriate procedures for taking students on an excursion, as set out by the school and its governing education department, including completion of relevant permission forms.

Insurance

ARU Sports Injury and Liability Insurance Scheme provides a basic level of insurance for players, members and officials associated with club rugby. All clubs affiliated with ARU and/or the various State Unions and their affiliated unions are automatically covered under the plan from March 1, for a period of 12 months. All participants (Players, Coaches, Officials) must be registered with ARU in order to obtain coverage.

The insurance scheme referred to above does not provide sports accident insurance coverage for Activities that are run at a school or when a school attends an Activity as part of a school excursion. Such insurance coverage is the sole responsibility of the individual school through their school accident policy. Optional sports accident coverage can be arranged on application. ARU does provide public liability coverage and professional indemnity coverage for ARU staff delivering these programs under ARU National Insurance Scheme.

Waiver

You acknowledge that participation in the Activities may carry with it certain dangers including the risk of injury and damage to property, and agree, to the extent permitted by law, to waive all claims for liability against any participant (including players, coaches, volunteers and administrators) and release every such participant from all liability that may be incurred in connection with your participation in the Activities.

Medical Treatment

In the event that a child participating in the event is injured and the parent/guardian/teacher of the child is not present, ARU will arrange such medical, ambulance or hospital care it deems necessary. The parent/guardian of the child will meet all expenses associated with that care.
